Clinic information

Otaki: 21, 22 & 23 Oct 2017

TIMING:

Saturday: 9.30am registration/payments/cuppa, 10am start, 4pm finish (at the latest)

Sunday & Monday: 9.30-3.30pm

(If you're bringing a horse please arrive in time to get them settled in a yard before we start).

This clinic is mostly training on the ground, but there will be an opportunity to transfer our learning to ridden work on the Sunday/Monday. Helmets are compulsory, and no horses under 4 years old to be ridden please (unless discussed prior). If you can't or don't wish to ride, that is absolutely no problem, you will still learn a lot by watching or I can give you exercises to play with on the ground if you prefer.

FACILITIES:

Our host is Jane Lenaghan. Ground fees per horse is \$10/day.

If you would like your horse to stay the night please speak to Jane, this will cost \$10/night.

There is a small kitchen available for our use. Tea and coffee will be provided, please bring your lunch.

TO BRING:

- Folding chair
- The remainder of your clinic / ground fees (to be given to me in cash on Saturday morning if possible please)
- A bumbag or something to put treats in (or cash to buy a treat pouch on the day)
- LOTS of small treats such as pellet feed, chopped carrots etc. We will go through a lot of small treats in the early stages of training so bring loads. Think of how much you think you'll need, and then double it. You can always take it home again if you don't use it, but if you run out you won't be able to participate.
- Hat / raincoat etc (the arena/yards are outdoors)
- Pad and pen if you wish to take notes
- Gear for your horse: On Saturday you will just need a decent lead-rope and a halter (flat halter or rope, whatever your horse is comfortable in). If you want to ride on the Sunday then bring your tack (I don't care if you ride bareback or in a saddle, halter or bridle, whatever you like as long as your horse is properly under control at all times).
- I will have clickers, various books, pouches and other gear there on the day. See my website for details and prices of what I have available – clickertraining.co.nz - and bring extra cash in case you want anything on the day.
